HOW WE OPERATE

Since the pandemic our operation has expanded and evolved to accommodate the highest levels of demand we've seen since we started more than 10 years ago.

Most of the food in our parcels comes from a variety of sources, including the general public, supermarkets, schools and faith groups. Levels of demand mean we also have to fundraise to ensure we can provide enough parcels.



REACHING OUT

Supporting clients at the point of crisis is vital but we want to be more than a short-term fix for vulnerable people, who can often find themselves in a cycle of poverty.

We also use our expertise to gain insight from our clients, so we can provide more tailored help. This includes support with wellbeing and lifeskills, through cookery courses and a community café.



HOW CAN YOUR BUSINESS GET INVOLVED?

There are a whole range of ways you can support us, including:

Workplace food drives – If you're back in the office, could you do a regular food collection together and drop it down to us?
